

2015 Extra Help Program

Some people with limited income and resources may be able to get **Federal Extra Help** to pay the costs of their Medicare Prescription Drug Plan – monthly premiums, annual deductibles and prescription copays. Income limits are based on the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), which changes every February. **2015 Monthly FPL = \$981 Individual and \$1,328 Couple.**
