What happens if I choose IRIS?

If you decide you want to participate in IRIS, the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) will send the Independent Consultant Agency your name, contact information, and the amount of money you will have available to spend on your supports and services.

The Independent Consultant Agency will contact you to begin the process of choosing an Independent Consultant. This involves talking with a person at the Independent Consultant Agency about where you live, what types of assistance you are interested in, and any preferences you might have. You choose your consultant from a list of consultants who are available in your area.

What are Independent Consultants?

- Independent Consultants are available in your area to help you create a supports and services plan and help you put that plan into action.
- Independent Consultants are caring and creative people who value the independence, choice, freedom and responsibility that IRIS provides.
- Independent Consultants are familiar with community resources and the state's long-term care systems.
- Some Independent Consultants may be IRIS participants as well.
- ## Independent Consultants are available to assist you in doing many different things:
 - · Pursue your hopes and dreams
 - Find workers and service providers
 - · Get involved in the community
 - Develop a "back-up" plan that will keep you safe
 - Measure how well your supports are working
- Link you to a support broker if you wish to purchase additional support
