## Approved SPAs:

- AL SPA 07-002: Alabama was the first State to submit their SPA; approved on 5/24/07
- **OR 07-014**: Oregon's SPA was approved on 1/10/08
- AR SPA 07-023: Arkansas' SPA was approved on 3/27/08
- **FL SPA 07-007**; Amended **FL SPA 09-009**: Florida's SPA was approved on 3/28/08 and amended on 6/29/09 to remove the enrollment cap
- NJ SPA 08-03: New Jersey's SPA was approved 7/23/08
- **TX 08-036**: Texas' SPA was approved 7/29/09
- CA 09-006: SPA was approved 9/29/09 effective 10/1/09

## Of the 7 approved SPAs (AL, AR, FL, NJ, OR, TX, CA):

- Offers self-direction of PCS State plan benefit: FL, AR, NJ, TX, CA
- Offers self-direction of section 1915(c) waiver services: AL, OR, FL, AR
- Offers opportunity Statewide: OR, FL, AR, NJ, TX, CA
- Offers opportunity less than Statewide: AL
- Offers the cash option: AL, OR, AR, NJ, CA
- Does not offer the cash option: TX, FL
- Limits the number of individuals who can participate: AL, AR
- No cap on the number of individuals who can participate: FL (amended SPA), NJ, TX, OR, CA
- Allows participants to hire legally liable relatives: TX, AL, OR, NJ, FL, CA
- Does not allow participants to hire legally liable relatives: AR
- Allows participants to appoint a representative to direct the PAS on their behalf: TX, AL, AR, OR, NJ, FL, CA
